Dear Friends,

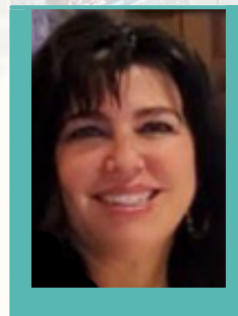

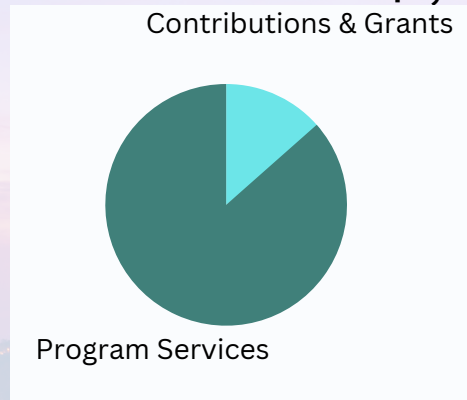

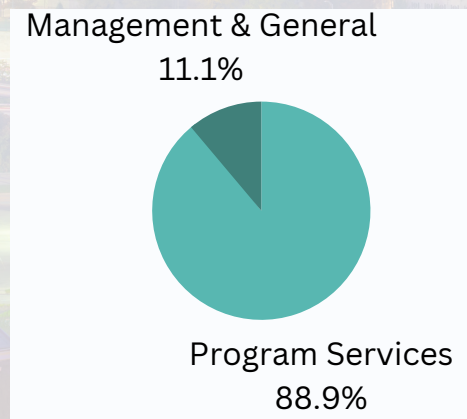
2022 Revenue

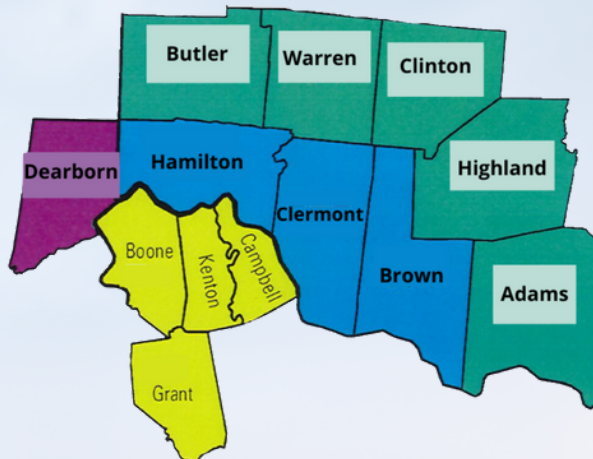

CincySmiles Dental Center provides dental treatment to anyone needing services with special attention to the most at-risk populations of the Greater Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky and SE Indiana area.

The DRC travels to the schools, medical and mental health care facilities, nursing homes, and social service agencies CincySmiles has partnered them to deliver dental treatment and oral health education services onsite using portable dental equipment.
